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TENDER FOR THE PROVISION OF CONSULTING SERVICES FOR THE DESIGN OF AN INTEGRATED WATER MANAGEMENT PLAN (IWMP) FOR THE FORMER CARONI SUGAR GROWING AREAS FOR THE MINISTRY OF FOOD PRODUCTION

THE Ministry of Food Production (MFP) is in the process of formulating strategies for managing water for agricultural purposes in Trinidad and Tobago.

In this regard, the Central Tenders Board is seeking proposals from consulting firms for the Provision of Consulting Services for the Design of an Integrated Water Management Plan for the former Caroni Sugar Growing Areas to be used for Agricultural Purposes for the Ministry of Food Production.

Proposals must be accompanied by—

- (a) valid Income Tax and Valued Added Tax Clearance Certificates issued by the Board of Inland Revenue and dated not more than six (6) months prior to the closing date for the receipt of proposals;
- (b) valid Certificate of Compliance issued in accordance with the National Insurance Act.

The original and five (5) copies each of the Technical and Financial Proposals should be placed in separate sealed envelopes clearly marked on the outside:

Envelope No. 1—Technical Proposal—Provision of Consulting Services for the Design of an Integrated Water Management Plan (IWMP) for the Former Caroni Sugar Growing Areas for the Ministry of Food Production.

Envelope No. 2— Financial Proposal—Provision of Consulting Services for the Design of an Integrated Water Management Plan (IWMP) for the Former Caroni Sugar Growing Areas for the Ministry of Food Production.

The name and address of the firm must be printed on Envelope No. 2—Financial Proposal.

The envelopes must be addressed to the Chairman, Central Tenders Board, 116, Frederick Street, Port-of-Spain and must be deposited in the Brown Tenders Box located in the lobby of the Board's Office not later than 1.00 p.m. on Thursday 23rd April, 2015.

Technical proposals will be opened shortly thereafter. An authorized representative of the firm may be present at the opening.

Proposals should be packaged to fit the slot on the Tenders Box, the dimensions of which are 37.5 cm x 5.5 cm.

The Central Tenders Board reserves the right to cancel the bidding process in its entirety or even partially, without defraying any cost incurred by any firm in submitting its proposals.

Late proposals will not be accepted in any circumstances.
