MADE BY THE COMMISSIONER OF POLICE UNDER SECTION 68(1) OF THE
MOTOR VEHICLES AND ROAD TRAFFIC ACT

THE TRAFFIC RESTRICTION (TEMPORARY PROVISIONS)
(PAN ON D'AVENUE) ORDER, 2015

1. This Order may be cited as the Traffic Restriction (Temporary Provisions) (Pan on D'Avenue) Order, 2015. Citation

2. This Order shall have effect between the hours of 4.00 p.m. on Saturday 22nd August, 2015 and 2.30 a.m. on Sunday 23rd August, 2015. Duration

3. Parking is prohibited on the following:

Parking
prohibited

(a) between Ariapita Avenue and Wrightson Road along—

(i) Ana Street;

(ii) French Street; and

(iii) Carlos Street;

(b) Colville Street, between Ariapita Avenue and Tragarete Road;

(c) Taylor Street, between Warren Street and Ariapita Avenue;

(d) Warren Street, between Belle Smythe Street and Rosalino Street;

(e) Hamilton Holder Street;

(f) O'Connor Street; and

(g) Belle Smythe Street.

4. Vehicular traffic and parking are prohibited along Ariapita Avenue, between O'Connor Street and Colville Street. Road closed
and vehicular

5. Notwithstanding—

Exception in
the case of
vehicles
conveying
steelbands

(a) clause 4, vehicles conveying steelbands are permitted on Ariapita Avenue, between O'Connor Street and Colville Street; and

(b) clause 3(c), vehicles conveying steelbands may park on Taylor Street.

Band route 6. Bands shall assemble on Taylor Street and then proceed east along Ariapita Avenue until Colville Street and, on completion of their performance, shall disassemble at the intersection of Colville Street and Ariapita Avenue.

Removal and
impounding
of vehicles
unlawfully
parked 7. Without prejudice to any other liability incurred by the commission of a summary offence, vehicles found parked in contravention of this Order may be removed by a member of the Police Service and impounded and dealt with in accordance with section 108(1)(b) of the Motor Vehicles and Road Traffic Act.
