ORDER

MADE BY THE COMMISSIONER OF POLICE UNDER SECTION 68(1) OF THE  
MOTOR VEHICLES AND ROAD TRAFFIC ACT

THE TRAFFIC RESTRICTION (TEMPORARY PROVISIONS)  
(INDEPENDENCE DAY PARADE, TOBAGO) ORDER, 2015

1. This Order may be cited as the Traffic Restriction (Temporary Provisions) (Independence Day Parade, Tobago) Order, 2015. Citation

2. This Order shall have effect from 7.00 a.m. to 11.00 a.m. on Monday 31st August, 2015. Duration

3. Vehicular traffic and parking are prohibited on the Claude Noel Highway, between the junction of Wilson Road and the Claude Noel Highway and the junction of the Claude Noel Highway and Windward Road. Vehicular traffic and parking prohibited

4. Parking is prohibited on the following:

- (a) Wilson Road, between Claude Noel Highway and Milford Road;
- (b) Post Office Street;
- (c) Garden Side Street, between Darrell Spring Road and Carrington Street;
- (d) Garden Side Street and Market Square public car park;
- (e) the NIB Mall car park; and
- (f) Carrington Street.

Parking prohibited

5. (1) Vehicular traffic approaching Scarborough—

- (a) from the east, shall turn onto Windward Road, Bacolet and continue along same;
- (b) from the west, shall turn south onto Orange Hill Road and then onto Milford Road; and
- (c) from Northside Road, shall continue south across the Claude Noel Highway onto Bacolet Extension Road.

Traffic routes

(2) Notwithstanding clause 3, motorists travelling west along the Claude Noel Highway and wishing to proceed onto Wilson Road or Plymouth Road may continue west along the Claude Noel Highway and turn north onto same.

No entry            6. Vehicular traffic shall not enter the Claude Noel Highway from—

- (a) Friends Field Road;
- (b) Bagatelle Road;
- (c) Calder Hall Road;
- (d) Northside Road;
- (e) Darrell Spring Road; and
- (f) Wilson Road.

Removal and  
impounding  
of vehicles  
unlawfully  
parked            7. Without prejudice to any other liability incurred by the  
commission of a summary offence, vehicles found parked in  
contravention of this Order may be removed by a member of the  
Police Service and impounded and dealt with in accordance with  
section 108(1)(b) of the Motor Vehicles and Road Traffic Act.
