ORDER

MADE BY THE MINISTER AFTER CONSULTATION WITH THE CHIEF JUSTICE  
UNDER SECTION 15A OF THE LEGAL PROFESSION ACT

THE LEGAL PROFESSION (ELIGIBILITY FOR ADMISSION)  
(NO. 10) ORDER, 2015

1. This Order may be cited as the Legal Profession (Eligibility for Admission) (No. 10) Order, 2015.

2. The person referred to in Part I of the Schedule, being a Commonwealth citizen admitted to practise law in England and Wales for not less than ten years, is eligible to be admitted to practise law in Trinidad and Tobago subject to the terms and conditions specified in Part II of the Schedule.

SCHEDULE

PART I

<i>Name</i>	<i>Professional Qualification</i>
Mr. Michael Anthony Green, QC	Of the Honourable Society of Lincoln's Inn: Barrister, admitted to practise at the Bar of England and Wales in July, 1987 and appointed Queen's Counsel in 2009.

PART II

Mr. Michael Anthony Green, QC, is eligible to be admitted to practise law as an Attorney-at-law in relation to the following cause and any matters, suits or other proceedings arising out of or in connection with the cause, namely:

- (1) C.V. 2010-01352—Clico Investment Bank in Compulsory Liquidation v. Louis Andre Monteil, Richard Trotman, Stone Street Capital Limited and First Capital Limited.
- (2) C.V. 2015-01442—Clico Investment Bank in Compulsory Liquidation v. Richard Trotman, Louis Andre Monteil and Lennox Archer.
- (3) A claim by Clico Investment Bank in Compulsory Liquidation against—
  - (a) Colonial Life Insurance Company (Trinidad) Limited;
  - (b) Trinidad and Tobago Central Depository Limited; and

- (c) CMMB Securities Limited seeking a declaration that Clico Investment Bank in Compulsory Liquidation is the beneficial owner of 11,786,000 shares in Republic Bank Limited such shares being the subject matter.
