NOTICE OF INTENTION TO MAKE AN ORDER REVOKING
COMPULSORY STANDARDS

NOTICE is hereby given in accordance with the Standards Act, Chap. 82:03, that the Minister of Trade and Industry on the recommendation of the Trinidad and Tobago Bureau of Standards, intends to make an Order revoking the following compulsory standards, with effect from 21st December, 2015:
