INTENTION TO MAKE AN ORDER DECLARING
A COMPULSORY STANDARD

NOTICE is hereby given in accordance with section 18(2) of the Standards Act, Chap. 82:03, that the Minister of Trade, Industry, Investment and Communications, on the recommendation of the Trinidad and Tobago Bureau of Standards, intends to make an Order declaring the standards listed in the First Column with the corresponding title listed in the Second Column as a compulsory standard, with effect from 27th March, 2015 for the purposes specified in the Third Column.

Notice is also given that this standard was notified in Legal Notice No. 272 of 2014.
