MADE BY THE MINISTER AFTER CONSULTATION WITH THE CHIEF JUSTICE
UNDER SECTION 15A OF THE LEGAL PROFESSION ACT

THE LEGAL PROFESSION (ELIGIBILITY FOR ADMISSION)
(NO. 3) ORDER, 2015

1. This Order may be cited as the Legal Profession (Eligibility for Admission) (No. 3) Order, 2015.

2. The person referred to in Part I of the Schedule, being a Commonwealth citizen admitted to practise law in England and Wales for not less than ten years, is eligible to be admitted to practise law in Trinidad and Tobago subject to the terms and conditions specified in Part II of the Schedule.

PART I

Mr. Andrew Robert Mitchell, QC,	Of the Honourable Society of Gray's Inn: Barrister, admitted to practise at the Bar of England and Wales in July, 1976 and appointed Queen's Counsel in 1998.

PART II

Mr. Andrew Robert Mitchell, QC, is eligible to be admitted to practise law as an Attorney-at-law in relation to the following matters and any other proceedings arising out of or in connection with the matters, namely:

Civil Appeal No. P067 of 2014—Mora Ven Holding Limited, Mora Oil Ventures Limited, George Nicolas III v Krishna Persad and Associates Limited and Krishna Persad; and

CV 2010-00118—In the matter of KPA Services Limited and In the matter of the Companies Act, Chap. 81:01.
