THE DOG CONTROL ACT, CHAP. 67:56

REGULATIONS

MADE BY THE MINISTER UNDER SECTION 28 OF THE DOG CONTROL ACT, CHAP. 67:56 AND SUBJECT TO NEGATIVE RESOLUTION OF PARLIAMENT

THE DOG CONTROL REGULATIONS, 2015

1. These Regulations may be cited as the Dog Control Regulations, Citation 2015.

2. In these Regulations—

“the Act” means the Dog Control Act, Chap. 67:56;

Interpretation

Act No. 11 of 2013

“adult dog” means a dog which is not less than six months old;

“breeding dog” means an un-neutered female dog that is not less than six months old;

“full-time attendant” means a person who works, either paid or unpaid, at least forty hours per week;

“part-time attendant” means a person who works, either paid or unpaid, less than forty hours per week.

3. (1) A fence referred to in section 9 of the Act shall be constructed of 10 gauge chain link wire held together securely at intervals of no less than 3 metres (approximately 10 feet) by 0.05 metre (2 inch) galvanized steel pipes or concrete columns measuring not less than 0.20 metre (approximately 8 inches) square, at least 1 metre (approximately 3 feet) of which are to be embedded in the earth and affixed securely on a 0.6 m by 0.6 m (2 feet by 2 feet) footing. ^{Fence and wall dimensions}

(2) A wall referred to in section 9 of the Act shall be constructed of 0.1 metre by 0.2 metre by 0.41 metre (4 inches by 8 inches by 16 inches) concrete or clay blocks attached to concrete columns measuring at

least 0.30 metre (approximately 8 inches) square and at least 1 metre (approximately 3 feet) of which are to be embedded in the earth and affixed securely thereto by at least two buckets of concrete, each bucket having a capacity of 3 cubic feet.

(3) The fence and wall referred to in subregulations (1) and (2) respectively, shall be—

- (a) at least 2.44 metres (approximately 8 feet) high; and
- (b) constructed and maintained in such a way so that the dog is not able to dig or otherwise escape under, over or through the fence or wall.

Muzzle
requirements

4. A muzzle referred to in section 5(2)(a) of the Act shall—

- (a) be securely fitted and placed on the mouth of the dog to prevent the dog from biting any person;
- (b) be made of durable weather resistant materials consisting either of double ply nylon or leather with a thickness of at least 3 millimetres (approximately 0.12 inch);
- (c) be of an open basket weave design; and
- (d) not interfere with the breathing, panting or vision of the dog.

Lead and collar
requirements

5. A lead referred to in section 5(2)(b) of the Act shall—

- (a) be made of weather resistant materials consisting either of double ply nylon or leather with a thickness of at least 3 millimetres (approximately 0.12 inch);
- (b) be able to be securely fastened to the collar or harness on the dog with a snap lock which shall contain a swivel-type mechanism to allow for turning and such collar shall—
 - (i) be of double ply nylon, leather with a thickness of at least 3 millimetres (approximately 0.12 inch) or padded with a sturdily placed hook for attaching the lead; and
 - (ii) have a minimum width of—
 - (A) 25 millimetres (approximately 1 inch) for a dog weighing not less than 20 kilograms (approximately 44 pounds);
 - (B) 40 millimetres (approximately 1.5 inches) for a dog weighing not less than 20 kilograms (approximately 44 pounds) and not more than 40 kilograms (approximately 88 pounds); or
 - (C) 50 millimetres (approximately 2 inches) for a dog weighing more than 40 kilograms (approximately 88 pounds);

- (c) have a minimum width of 25 millimetres (approximately 1 inch); and
- (d) be not more than 1.25 metres (approximately 4 feet) in length.

6. Where there is a change in relation to information contained on the register referred to in section 6 of the Act, the owner of a class A dog shall notify the local authority in the form set out as Form 9 in Schedule 1.

7. A notice under section 18 of the Act shall—

Notice

- (a) be a white rectangle measuring 200 millimetres (approximately 8 inches) by 300 millimetres (approximately 12 inches);
- (b) be made of a durable material;
- (c) contain the word “WARNING” in white capital letters 30 millimetres (approximately 1 inch) high on a red rectangular panel measuring 190 millimetres (approximately 7.5 inches) by 45 millimetres (approximately 1.75 inches) near the top of the rectangle referred to in paragraph (a);
- (d) contain below the panel referred to in paragraph (c), a red circle 160 millimetres (approximately 6.5 inches) in diameter containing a picture of the black head and neck of a dog 100 millimetres (approximately 4 inches) high (whether in colour or black and white); and
- (e) contain below the circle referred to in paragraph (d)—
 - (i) in respect of a class A dog, the words “CLASS A DOG” in capital letters 20 millimetres (approximately 1 inch) high; or
 - (ii) in respect of a dangerous class B dog, the words “DANGEROUS CLASS B DOG” in capital letters 20 millimetres (approximately 1 inch) high; and

be as set out as Diagram 1 in Schedule 2.

Schedule 2

8. (1) The owner of a kennel shall at all times ensure that—

Operations of kennels

- (a) the dogs are kept in enclosures suitable with respect to construction, size of quarters, number of dogs, exercising facilities, temperature, lighting, ventilation and cleanliness;
- (b) the dogs are adequately supplied with suitable food, drink, bedding material, adequately exercised and visited at suitable intervals;

- (c) the dogs are treated for external parasites and all reasonable precautions are taken to prevent and control the spread of infectious or contagious diseases among dogs;
 - (d) adequate and timely veterinary care is provided for sick or injured dogs;
 - (e) all reasonable precautions are taken to prevent and control injuries to the dogs (whether from the enclosure, other class A dogs or dangerous class B dogs);
 - (f) a breeding dog is not mated if they are less than one year old;
 - (g) a breeding dog does not give birth to more than six litters of pups each; and
 - (h) a breeding dog does not give birth to pups before the end of the period of twelve months beginning with the day on which it last gave birth to pups.
- (2) The owner of a kennel shall ensure that the staff to adult dog ratio is, at a minimum, the following:
- (a) one full-time attendant per twenty adult dogs; or
 - (b) one part-time attendant per ten adult dogs.
- (3) The enclosures referred to in subregulation (1)(a) shall—
- (a) be fully enclosed, constructed and maintained in such a way so that the dog is not able to dig or otherwise escape under, over or through the enclosure;
 - (b) be constructed in such a way so that a person cannot have access to the enclosure without the assistance of the owner of the kennel;
 - (c) be designed to prevent children from having access to the enclosure;
 - (d) have an area of not less than 32 feet (10 square metres) for each class A dog kept on the kennel premises;
 - (e) house only one class A dog per enclosure except where the class A dog is nursing or where the pups are less than six months old;
 - (f) have walls with a minimum height of 5.9 feet (1.8 metres) and a minimum width of 5.9 feet (1.8 metres);
 - (g) have a floor that is constructed of a non-skid, non-porous, non-corrosive material to minimize pooling of water and that is drained in such a manner so that there is no contact of waste water between enclosures;

- (h) have a weatherproof sleeping area for each dog in the enclosure;
- (i) have the walls, roof and the door or gate made of concrete blocks, clay blocks, iron or chain link wire or a combination of these materials, of sufficient strength and durability as described in regulation 3, to prevent the escape of the dog;
- (j) have a gate or door which shall contain a self-closing and self-latching mechanism that enables the enclosure to be securely locked when the dog is in the enclosure; and
- (k) be situated so as not to require a person to pass through it to gain access to other parts of the property on which it is situated.

(4) The owner of a kennel who contravenes this regulation commits an offence and is liable on summary conviction to a fine of fifty thousand dollars.

9. The forms required to be prescribed under sections 6(1), 6(4), 7(1), 7(2), 7(5)(a)(i), 7(5)(a)(iv), 9(3), 9(4), 9(5), 25(1), 25(2) and 25(3) of the Act ^{forms} are the forms set out as Forms 1 to 12, respectively, in Schedule 1. Schedule 1
