NOTICE is hereby given that Caribbean LNG Limited is desirous of establishing a mid-scale LNG liquefaction facility at the Labidco Estate, La Brea, in the south-western part of Trinidad and that this project is deemed a designated activity pursuant to the Certificate of Environmental Clearance (Designated Activities) Order (as amended) thus requiring a Certificate of Environmental Clearance pursuant to section 35 of the Environmental Management Act, Chap. 35:05 ("the Act"). Caribbean LNG Limited has applied for a Certificate of Environmental Clearance ("the Certificate") from the Environmental Management Authority ("the Authority") for this project.
