ORDER

Made by the President under section 123(2) of the Constitution and subject to negative resolution of Parliament

THE APPOINTMENT OF THE COMMISSIONER OF POLICE AND DEPUTY COMMISSIONER OF POLICE (QUALIFICATION AND SELECTION CRITERIA) ORDER, 2015

- 1. This Order may be cited as the Appointment of the Citation Commissioner of Police and Deputy Commissioner of Police (Qualification and Selection Criteria) Order, 2015.
- 2. (1) A candidate for the office of Commissioner of Police shall be a Qualification national of Trinidad and Tobago and shall have—
 - (a) a degree from a University recognized by the Ministry responsible for higher education in any of the following:
 - (i) law;
 - (ii) criminal justice;
 - (iii) criminology;
 - (iv) police service management; or
 - (v) any other relevant degree; and
 - (b) no less than fifteen years' experience of increasing responsibility in law enforcement.
- (2) A candidate for the office of Deputy Commissioner of Police shall be a national of Trinidad and Tobago and have—
 - (a) the qualifications stipulated in subclause (1)(a); and
 - (b) no less than ten years' experience of increasing responsibilty in law enforcement.

Candidate not to be a bankrupt or convicted of a criminal offence 3. A candidate for the post of Commissioner of Police or Deputy Commissioner of Police shall not be a bankrupt and shall not have a conviction for a criminal offence.
