UPON READING the Fixed Date Claim Form filed on March 1st, 2019 and the affidavit Principal Deponent sworn and filed on March 1st, 2019 together with the exhibits attached thereto.

AND UPON DETERMINING that this matter be deemed fit for an urgent hearing.

AND UPON HEARING Attorney-at-Law for the Claimant.

IT IS HEREBY DECLARED that Pursuant to section 22B(3)(a) of the Anti-Terrorism Act, Chap. 12:07, the Defendant, **HAMZA** also known as **USAMA** also known as **MUHAMMAD** also known as **BIN LADEN** DOB: 9 May 1989 POB: Jeddah, Saudi Arabia Good quality a.k.a.: na Low quality a.k.a.: na Nationality: Saudi Arabia Passport no: na National identification no: na Address: na

Listed on: 28 Feb. 2019 Other information: Son of Usama bin Laden (deceased). Announced by Aiman Muhammed Rabi al-Zawahiri (QDi.006) as an official member of Al-Qaida (QDe.004). Has called for followers of Al-Qaida to commit terror attacks. Is seen as the most probable successor of al-Zawahiri., listed under the rubric **QDi. 421 at** page 56, 1st paragraph of the United Nations Security Council Sanctions List concerning ISIL (DA'ESH) and Al-Qaida dated March 1, 2019 and designated by the United Nations Security Council 1267/1989/2253 Committee on February 28, 2019 is a listed entity for the purposes of the Anti-Terrorism Act, Chapter 12:07 ("the Act").

IT IS ORDERED that:

1. Service of this order be dispensed with;

- 2. Pursuant to section 22B(3)(b) of the Act that the property (i) owned or controlled by the Defendant;
 - (ii) wholly or jointly owned or controlled, directly or indirectly, by the Defendant; and
 - (iii) derived or generated from funds or other assets owned or controlled directly or indirectly by the Defendant, be frozen;
- 3. Pursuant to section 22B(4D)(b) of the Act, the Registrar of the Supreme Court do serve an Office Copy of the Order on the Financial Intelligence Unit immediately in accordance with the Civil Proceedings Rules 1998 (as amended);
- 4. Pursuant to section 22B(5) of the Act, the Attorney General shall within seven (7) days after the date of this Order, cause a copy of the Order and a statement that the matter will be reviewed every six (6) months, to be published in the Trinidad and Tobago Gazette and in two (2) daily newspapers of general circulation in Trinidad and Tobago;
- 5. Liberty to apply; and
- 6. There be no order as to costs.

FINANCIAL INTELLIGENCE UNIT MINISTRY OF FINANCE PUBLIC NOTICE

FATF's LIST OF JURISDICTIONS WITH AML/CFT DEFICIENCIES

NOTICE IS GIVEN that pursuant to Section 17(1) (a) of the Financial Intelligence Unit Act of Trinidad and Tobago Chap. 72:01, the Financial Intelligence Unit of Trinidad and Tobago is required to publish a list of countries identified by the Financial Action Task Force (FATF) as jurisdictions that have strategic antimoney laundering and counter financing of terrorism (AML/CFT) deficiencies.

AND NOTICE IS GIVEN that, the FATF's public statement dated February 22, 2019 identified the following jurisdictions as having strategic AML/CFT deficiencies and the measures which must be taken.

FATF PUBLIC STATEMENT ISSUED FEBRUARY 22, 2019

A. JURISDICTIONS SUBJECT TO A FATF CALL FOR THE APPLICATION OF COUNTER-MEASURES AND ENHANCED DUE DILIGENCE MEASURES.

DEMOCRATIC PEOPLE'S REPUBLIC OF KOREA (DPRK)

The FATF calls on its members and urges all jurisdictions to advise their financial institutions to give special attention to business relationships and transactions with the DPRK, including DPRK companies, financial institutions, and those acting on their behalf. In addition to enhanced scrutiny, the FATF further calls on its members and urges all jurisdictions to apply effective counter-measures, and targeted financial sanctions in accordance with applicable United Nations Security Council Resolutions, to protect their financial sectors from money laundering, financing of terrorism and weapons of mass destruction (WMD) proliferation financing (ML/FT/PF) risks emanating from the DPRK.

IRAN

The FATF remains concerned with the terrorist financing risk emanating from Iran and the threat this poses to the international financial system until Iran implements the measures required to address the deficiencies identified in their Action Plan. The FATF, therefore, calls on its members and urges all jurisdictions to continue to advise their financial institutions to apply enhanced due diligence to business relationships and transactions with natural and legal persons from Iran, consistent with FATF Recommendation 19, including: (1) obtaining information on the reasons for intended transactions; and (2) conducting enhanced monitoring of business relationships, by increasing the number and timing of controls applied, and selecting patterns of transactions that need further examination.
